



## Youth House Rules

Safety and enjoyment of the game is our main goal.

Referees, league officials, and facility employees reserve the right to remove any player or spectators from the building at any time.

- Five (5) minute warm-up.
- Four (4) ten (10) minute quarters **OR** two (2) twenty (20) minute halves.
- One (1) minute break between quarters **OR** two (2) minute break at halftime.
- Each team is allowed one (1) thirty (30) second timeout per game.
  
- \$5 Ref fee (per team) U6 and younger. \$10 Ref fee (per team) U8 and older. Fees due at the start of each game.
- In the event of a schedule conflict both teams must agree, by email, with a minimum one week notice for any schedule changes to be approved.
- If a team forfeits the game they will pay both referee fees for that particular game. The forfeiting team will not be able to play their next scheduled game until the fee is paid.
  
- Roster: Fifteen (15) player maximum per team.
- Once you replace a player on your roster, you cannot bring them back unless you pay for them again.
- Teams must have a minimum of five players to begin game.
- No more than 2 NON-playing members on the bench at any time. This is to include Coaching Staff.  
(Kids not playing must be in the bleachers)
- Players must be rostered to play. The use of non-rostered players will result in a forfeit.
- Referees and league officials may request to view photo ID of any player at any time.
  
- Spitting / Gum = **BLUE CARD** - Second Offense = **RED CARD**.
- (U8 & up) If any player kicks the ball and it hits the roof, one penalty shot will be awarded to the other team.
- Every five (5) teams fouls will result in shootout from the white line. (1 on 1, 5 seconds, or 5 touches)
- A **RED CARD** results in ejection from game plus a **one game suspension**.
- Any player who receives a **RED CARD** must leave the field in a timely manner. Failure to do so or any effort to return to the field will result in removal from league with **NO REFUND**.
- Two **RED CARDS** in one season will result in removal from league with **NO REFUND**.
- Ties in standings will be decided as follows: 1. Points 2. Goals For 3. Goals Against 4. Head to Head 5. Coin Toss.
- Games ending in a tie will result in a 3 player shoot out from the white line. (One on one with the goalkeeper). If both teams tie after the shoot out, the result will be a tie in standings.
- Ties during championship game will result in a 5 minute sudden death overtime.
